 - Exploring genetic pathways linked to Alzheimer's to help identify precision therapies
 - Identifying genetics, lifestyle, and other factors that reduce the risk of Alzheimer's

ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE FACTS

- More than 6 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's.
- About 1 in 9 people over age 65 has Alzheimer's.
- In 2022, Alzheimer's and other dementias will cost the nation \$321 billion. By 2050, these costs could reach nearly \$1 trillion.
- 1 in 3 seniors dies with Alzheimer's or another form of dementia.
